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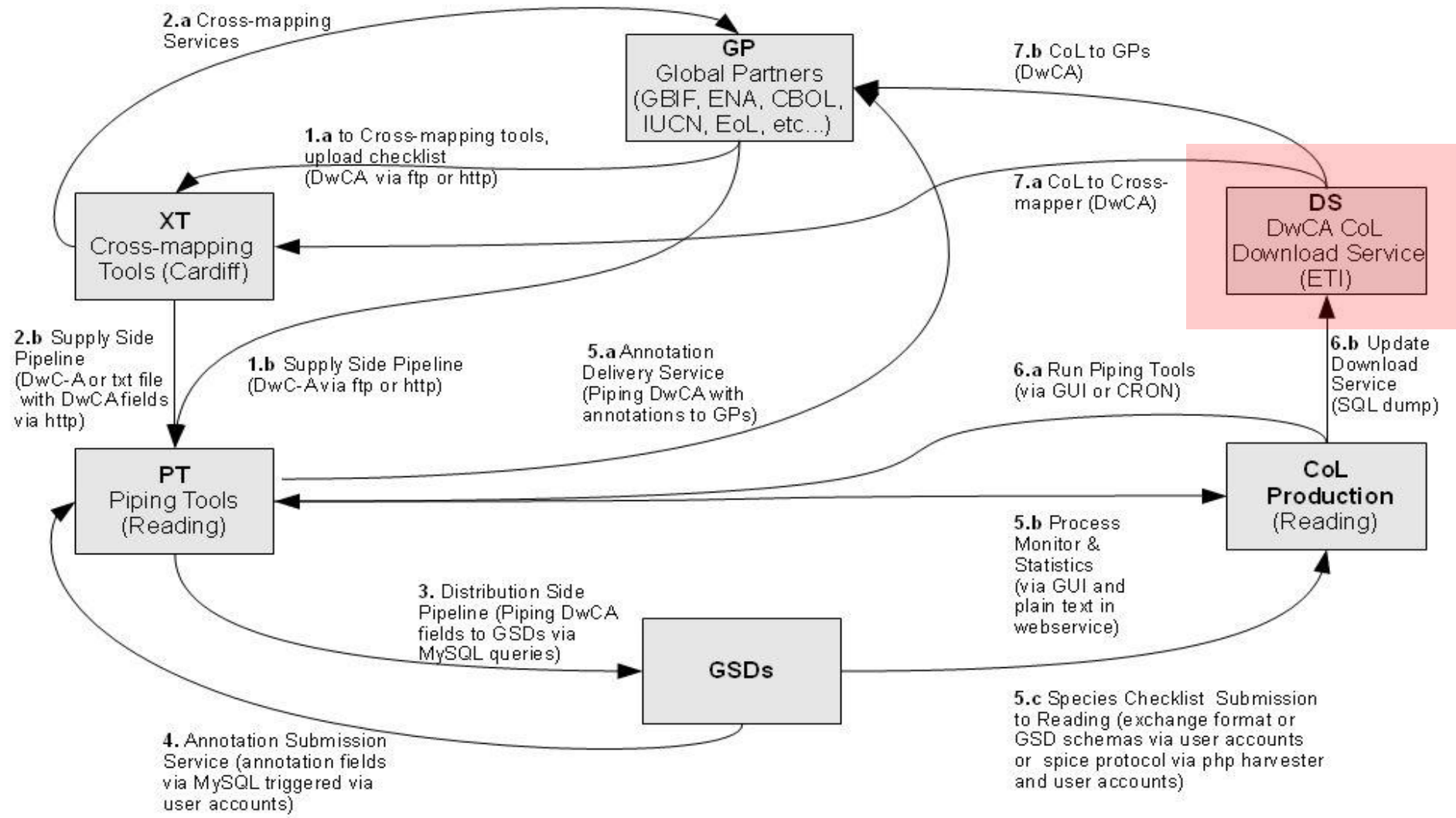

## Why it was created

One of the tasks in the project was to establish a workflow that delivers refreshed instances of Catalogue of Life taxonomy within the very heterogeneous working platforms and portals of the global programme partners (GBIF, EBI, ECBOL, IUCN and LifeWatch), using a CoL download service as its base.

## DwCA Download Service Features

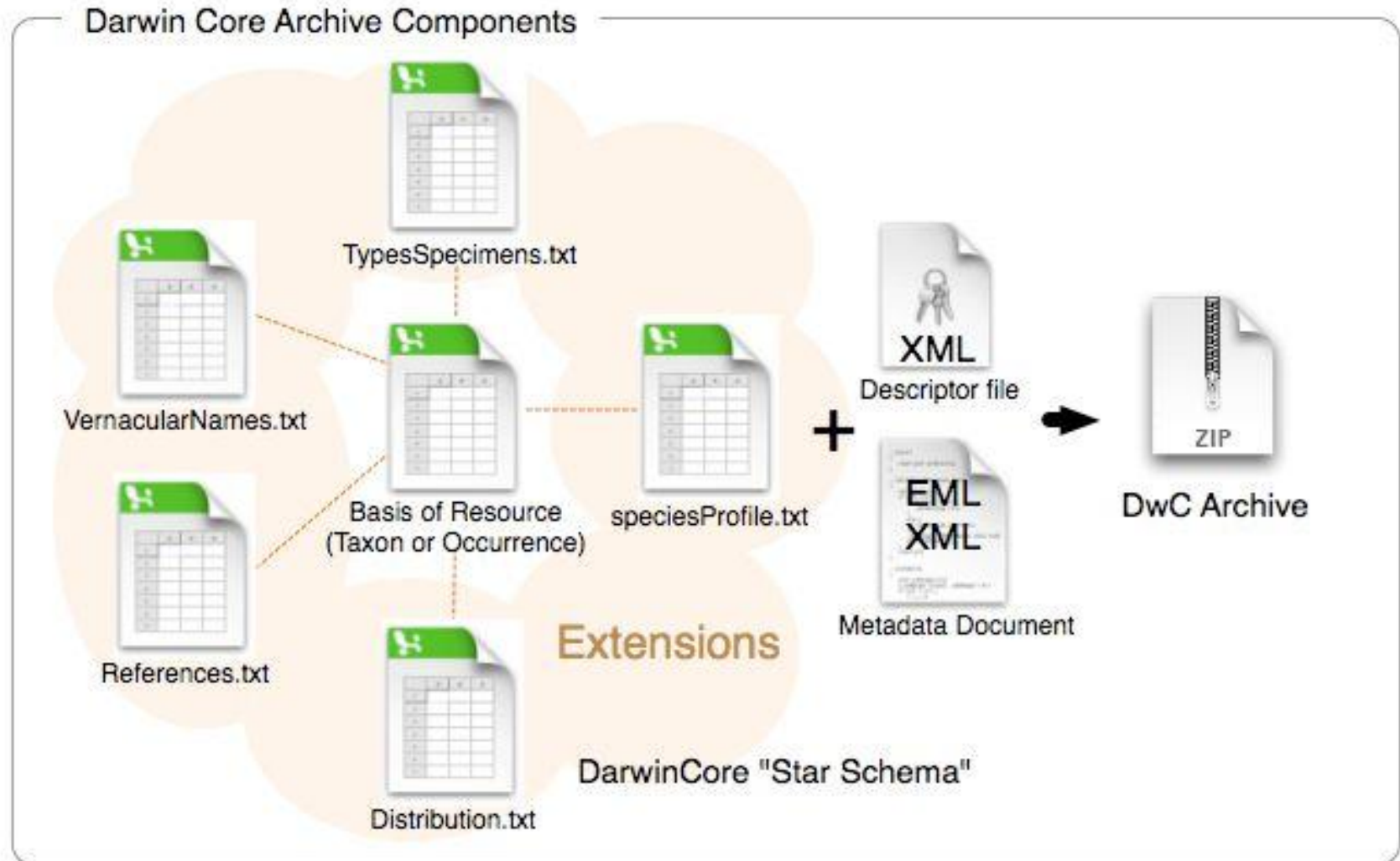
- Download the complete, latest CoL taxonomy
- Download an earlier CoL taxonomy
- Download a taxonomic group from the CoL
- Download a set with the 'core fields'
- Download only higher classification
- Use the GUI to download
- Use the Webservices to download
- Use the import scripts to import the DwCA data in a SQL database

This page offers an interface on the application that exports data from the Species 2000 & ITIS Catalogue of Life: 2013 Annual Checklist (2013-04-18) in the [Darwin Core Archive format](#). Data can also be exported using [a webservice](#). The resulting archives can be imported into custom MySQL, PostgreSQL, SQLite and MS SQL Server databases using import scripts included in each archive. These scripts can also be [downloaded separately](#).

The export can be narrowed down to a specific taxon by selecting it from the menus. E.g. if you want to limit your export to a specific order, you can select that order from the menu by typing its name or by clicking the Show all button. By default, the complete data is exported but you can further limit the export by selecting a different option. Hover over the buttons to see exactly what is exported for each option.
